- Year 4 know how to sculpt clay and other mouldable materials.

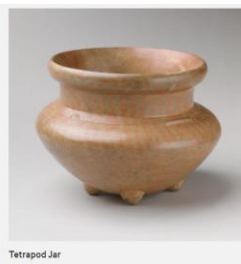
Sticky Knowledge

Vocabulary

Observation	Studying a form carefully to pick out key features,
Blending	Merging different colours or shades to create a natural gradient,
Shade	Using a given material to create darker/lighter tones
Carving	Mark making by scratching and cutting. Such as in wood or jade.
Mural	A painting created directly onto a wall.
Sculpture	A 3D piece of art. Carving, casting or shaping.
Evaluate	To identify positives and areas of improvement.
Hieroglyphics	Writing that consists of images/pictures/symbols.
Ceramics	Pots and other materials made from clay.



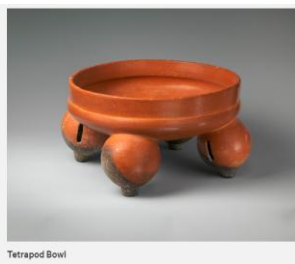
Tetrapod Jar
