Sticky Knowledge

Rounders is a bat and ball game played between two teams.

Rounders involves batting and running around a circuit of bases. Opponents use fielding to prevent the batter running around the bases.




Fielding involves catching, tracking, stopping and throwing the ball.



Striking involves hitting a target (normally a ball) with our hand or a bat.

Opponents use bowling and fielding to try to get the batters out.



Cricket involves batting. Batters try to protect their wicket and score runs.

When fielding in any sport, it is important to work as a team, thinking about our position and the position of others.
