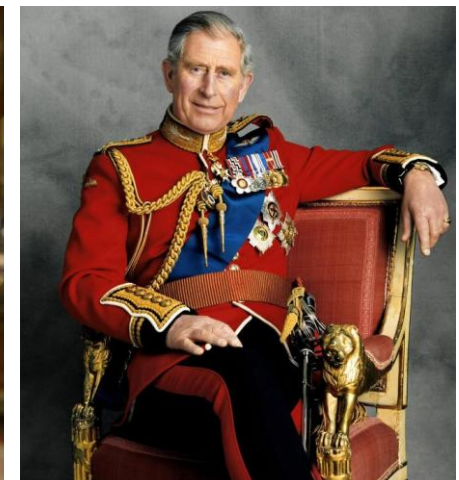

## Sticky Knowledge

- Queen Elizabeth I reigned from 1558 to 1603.
- Queen Elizabeth I was born in 1533 and died aged 69.
- There are no photos of Queen Elizabeth I because she was alive before cameras were invented, so people were painted instead.
- Queen Elizabeth did not get married or have children.
- Queen Elizabeth II was the reigning monarch for the UK, she celebrated her 70<sup>th</sup> Jubilee (Platinum Jubilee) in May 2022 and reigned for longer than any other British monarch.
- Queen Elizabeth II was born in 1926 and died in 2022.
- King Charles III, our current monarch was born in 1948 and came to the throne in 2022.

Elizabethan	The time when Queen Elizabeth I ruled England, from 1558 to 1603.
Reign	To rule over a country as king or queen.
Monarch	A ruler such as a king, queen, or emperor.
Portrait	a picture of a person usually showing the face
Royal	Relating to the king or queen
Tudor	The Tudors were a royal family who ruled England and Wales from 1485 until 1603.
