### Prior Learning

Children have...

- Shared their learning through performances in their class assembly and/or other school events
- Children have analysed their performance and discuss 'www' and 'ebi' (what went well, even better if)
- Children sing in unison and in simple two parts.
- Children become aware of being 'in tune' and can rejoin a song if 'lost'.
- Some children will have enjoyed exploring singing solo.
- Sing two/three part rounds with more confidence and increasing pitch accuracy
- Sing confidently as part of a small group or solo being aware of posture and good diction
- Copy short phrases and be able to sing up and down in step independently

### Sticky Knowledge

Children will...

- Children sing in unison and in simple two parts.
- Some children will enjoy singing solos and/or rapping.
- Sing as part of a three part round
- Sing a second part of a two part song with increasing confidence
- Sing songs in a wide variety of styles, showing accuracy and expression
- Perform a song showing an awareness of phrasing and the shape of the melody
- Sing independently with increasing confidence and accuracy
- Breathe in the correct place when singing
